Donated Engines Help Students

The August meeting of the Iowa Waste Exchange in Des Moines was attended by several representatives from the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program. The meeting provided an opportunity for reuse and recycling facilitators from Iowa and Nebraska to exchange information, share success stories, and discuss program information.

During the course of the meeting, an Exchange facilitator from Iowa mentioned that American Honda in Davenport, Iowa was willing to donate new motorcycle

engines to schools for use in auto shop classes. Kathleen Jacobson, a Nebraska Materials Exchange facilitator, immediately thought of Southeast Community College (SECC).

Kathleen contacted Ken Jefferson, Chairman of SECC's Motorcycle/ATV/Power Products Program, and asked him if he was interested in the engines. The engines were needed for the motorcycle repair classes offered at SECC, but a serious obstacle remained. How were they going to pick up the large engines in Davenport, Iowa and transport them back to Lincoln?

Mr. Jefferson enlisted the help of

Cliff Sawyer, Chairman of SECC's Professional Truck Driver Training Program. Mr. Sawyer saw an opportunity to provide several of his students with much needed over-the-road driving experience. Several days later, two student drivers from the truck driving school were headed for Davenport to pick up 20 engines valued at over \$56,000!

According to Mr. Jefferson, the engines will be used in motorcycle engine repair classes for a minimum of two years. Approximately 15-18 students per year attend these classes.

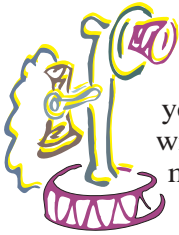
After the motorcycles have outlived their usefulness for the college, they will be salvaged as aluminum scrap or donated to high school shop classes. Southeast Community College has already donated two of the new engines to local high schools.

Thanks to the facilitators at the Iowa Waste Exchange, Kathleen, Ken, and Cliff for working together to provide these students with the materials they need to expand their educational opportunities!

Wireless Waste...

Providing a Lifeline

A study conducted by INFORM, a national environmental research organization, identified cellular phones and their accessories as an increasingly urgent waste stream problem. The study concluded that by the year 2005, over 130 million cellular phones will be discarded annually. Another 500 million phones are estimated to be stockpiled in closets and drawers. These phones will also find their way into our landfills over the next several years.



Because cell phones are so small, the problem of disposal would appear to be minimal. However, 130 million cell phones is the equivalent of 65,000 tons of "wireless waste". Just like computers, these phones contain toxic mercury, cadmium, lead and other poisonous materials. These toxic materials could eventually pollute streams, rivers, and groundwater.

The problem will only increase as the phones become more affordable and technology improves, increasing the likelihood that they will be viewed as disposable. Typically, cell phones are used for only 18 months before they are discarded for a more current model.



Of course, the problem is global. There are currently over one billion cell phones in use around the world. Australia, Japan, and Europe have had some success in addressing this growing problem, primarily by pressuring cell phone producers to reduce the level of toxic materials used in manufacturing the phones. Australia has even implemented the world's first and only nationwide take-back program for cell phone recycling.

In the United States, there is currently no nationwide mandate for the reduction of toxins in cell phones or the implementation of industry take-back programs. Some states are currently considering legislation that would make manufacturers of cell phones and accessories responsible for the waste disposal costs associated with the devices.

Currently, the best option for your unused cell phone is to donate it for refurbishment and reuse. These donated phones are used in a variety of different programs. Some phones are shipped to Third World countries where they can provide affordable, technologically advanced communication for many people.

Other phones are reprogrammed to dial 911 or other emergency services. These phones are often distributed to schools, neighborhood watch groups, or the elderly. One of the most common uses for these recycled phones is in domestic violence shelters where they are given to battered women to use in the case of emergency.



In 1996 The Wireless Foundation of Washington, began the "Call to Protect Program." The program collects unused cellular phones, refurbishes and reprograms them to dial 911, and then redistributes the phones to domestic violence shelters across the country. The Call to Protect Program is a partnership that also includes Motorola and the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence.



Thousands of phones have been supplied to victims of domestic violence, case workers, and victim assistance volunteers. A recent survey conducted by The Wireless Foundation found that 40% of participating shelters said victims have used the Call to Protect phones in the case of emergency. The otherwise discarded phones have provided a lifeline for domestic abuse victims as well as raised awareness.

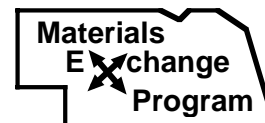
In Nebraska, domestic violence shelters like Haven House in Wayne, Friendship Home in Lincoln, Blue Valley Crisis Intervention in Fairbury, and The Coordinated Intervention System for Domestic Abuse (CISDA) in Crete, have all received phones through this recycling program.

If you have an unused cellular phone you would like to donate to the Call to Protect Program, just drop it off at any Cellular One or Alltel location. For more information about this program and others using donated, refurbished cell phones, you can log on to the website at www.donateaphone.com.

Since 2001, the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program has diverted 308,209 pounds of computers and other electronic waste from the landfill through reuse and recycling. Our facilitators have also successfully helped over 40 nonprofit organizations and schools find usable computer equipment that would have otherwise gone to the landfill.
