### CP Recovery Recycling Computers

Got an old computer to get rid of? It seems most people do. The National Safety Council believes the number of personal computers deemed obsolete in 2002 will exceed the number of new computers shipped. It is estimated that by the year 2004, the U.S. will have over 315 million obsolete computers in need of disposal. Because computers contain toxic materials such as lead and mercury, dumping them in the local landfill is causing serious concerns about ground, water, and air contamination.

On July 30, representatives from several recycling and reuse programs in Southeast Nebraska met at CP Recovery in Omaha for a demonstration of a process developed to maximize reuse and recycling of computer components. With a grant from the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality, CP Recovery was able to purchase the equipment needed to separate the CRT glass from computer monitors and televisions.

After the CRT tube is detached from the rest of the monitor, it is placed in a glass cutting machine which separates the monitor glass from the tube glass that contains lead. The monitor glass is then sent back to a recycler in Pennsylvania, which uses the glass for new CRT monitors. The process is known as "Glass to Glass" recycling.

Despite the technological advances

made in the process, it is still labor intensive. Each computer monitor must be dismantled by hand, separating out all the metal and plastic. These components are then baled and sent to local recyclers.

Dick McNeal of CP Recovery hopes to eventually recycle 20,000 lbs. of material per day. By the end of this year, they will have dismantled and recycled 300,000 lbs. worth of obsolete computers and other electronic equipment.

The public can drop off their personal computers at CP Recovery's location on 7534 F Street in Omaha. They will also pick up large quantities of computer components in Omaha, Lincoln, and surrounding communities. They are charging about .35 cents/lb. for the service.

Currently, only about 10% of computers in the United States are being recycled. Keeping this material out of our landfills is becoming a major concern among environmental groups. Thanks in part to the efforts of CP Recovery, businesses and individuals in southeast Nebraska are being given an environmentally sound option for their obsolete computers.

### Orphan Desks Find New Students

### Volunteer Statistics Compiled by the Points of Light Foundation in 1999...

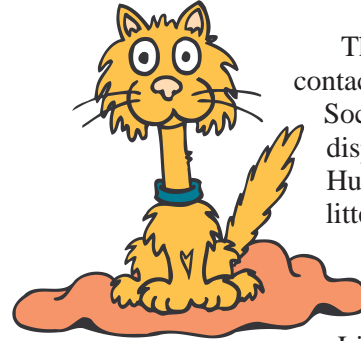
Nine out of ten individuals volunteered when asked.

### I Believe In Me Ranch

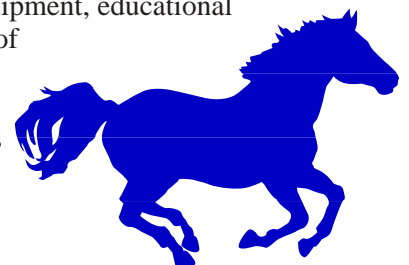

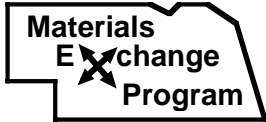

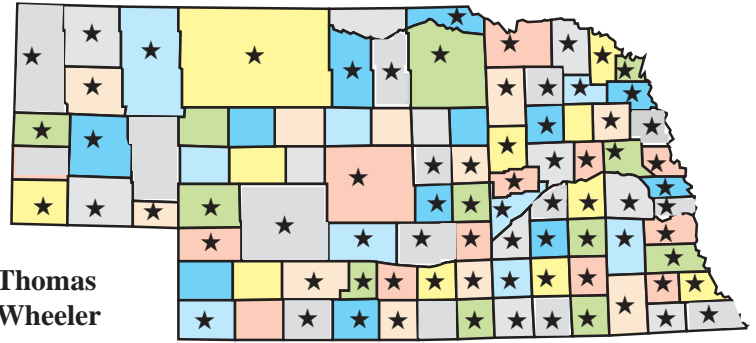

## USED OIL COLLECTION UPDATE

The third phase of the Used Oil Collection Program is moving forward. By April 2003, 11 more counties and local municipalities will be added to the 45 counties that are already participating. The new participants include the cities of South Sioux City, Papillion, Omaha and Norfolk. The new counties who have agreed to participate are Sarpy, Custer, Boone, Nance, Colfax, Stanton and Washington.

Most of the participants are located in the more heavily populated eastern half of the state. That means nearly 80% of Nebraska's population has access to the Used Oil Collection Program. The fourth phase of the program will target western counties in the state. The goal is to have 90% statewide participation by 2005.

The Used Oil Collection Program was implemented to protect Nebraska's water, air, and land from the pollution caused by improperly disposed oil. Too often, used oil is burned or illegally dumped. This action threatens the quality of life for every Nebraskan.

By providing an alternative method of disposal, pollution is reduced and a precious natural resource is recycled. Used oil can be utilized as an alternative fuel source, or recycled back into premium motor oils.

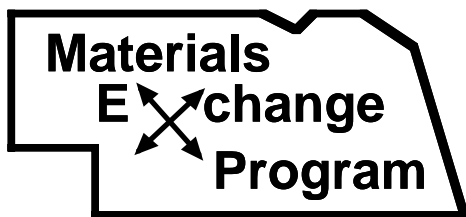
