## THEATER RENOVATION GETS HELP FROM THE EXCHANGE

In August of 2002, Todd and Katrina Trobee purchased the old movie theater in Ainsworth, Nebraska. The Royal Theater had seen better days and needed a great deal of work. For 3 months the Trobees, volunteers, and paid professionals worked to clean and update the theater.

When they reopened in October, the "new" theater included bathrooms (there had been none before the renovation) and a remodeled lobby. It proved cost-prohibitive, however, to replace the old, worn theater seats.

In November of 2003, the College of St. Mary in Omaha contacted the Exchange for help in relocating over 300 padded, auditorium seats. The auditorium at the College was being renovated and the seats, although in very good condition, could no longer be used.

Schools, churches, museums and other organizations were contacted about the availability of the auditorium seats. Even though the seats were free, there was little or no interest. Several months passed, and it became clear the seats might be destined for the landfill. In a final effort to locate an interested party, letters detailing the availability and condition of the seats were sent to movie theaters across the state.

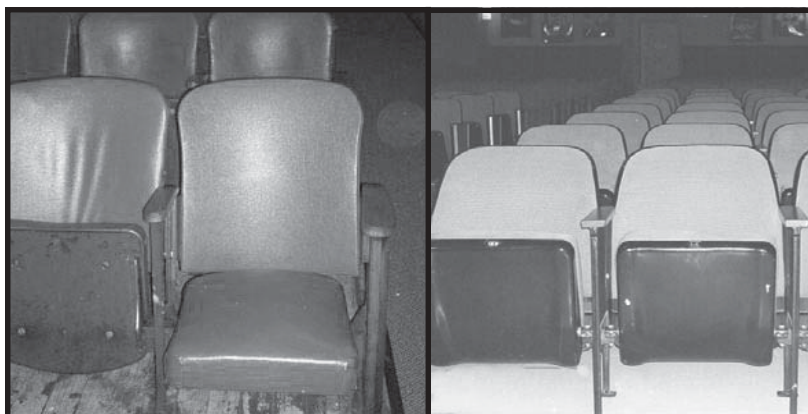
When the Trobees learned about the availability of the seats, they responded quickly to secure them for their theater renovation. They contacted the College of St.

Mary and arrangements were made to transport the seats from Omaha to Ainsworth. Even though transportation costs were \$1,100, the Trobees saved thousands of dollars over purchasing new, or even used seats.

Congratulations to everyone involved for working to find a reuse option for these seats and keeping them out of the landfill!

## Nebraska Used Oil Collection Program Update

The Used Oil Collection Program has enjoyed incredible growth since the pilot program was launched in 2000, and the program continues to expand across the state. Since used oil was banned from Nebraska landfills in 1994, this vital program provides citizens with an environmentally safe method for disposal of used oil.

When disposed of improperly or stored in inadequate containers, used oil can contaminate streams, groundwater, and soil. The program has

been especially beneficial for farmers in rural counties who may have stockpiled oil on their property due to limited disposal options.

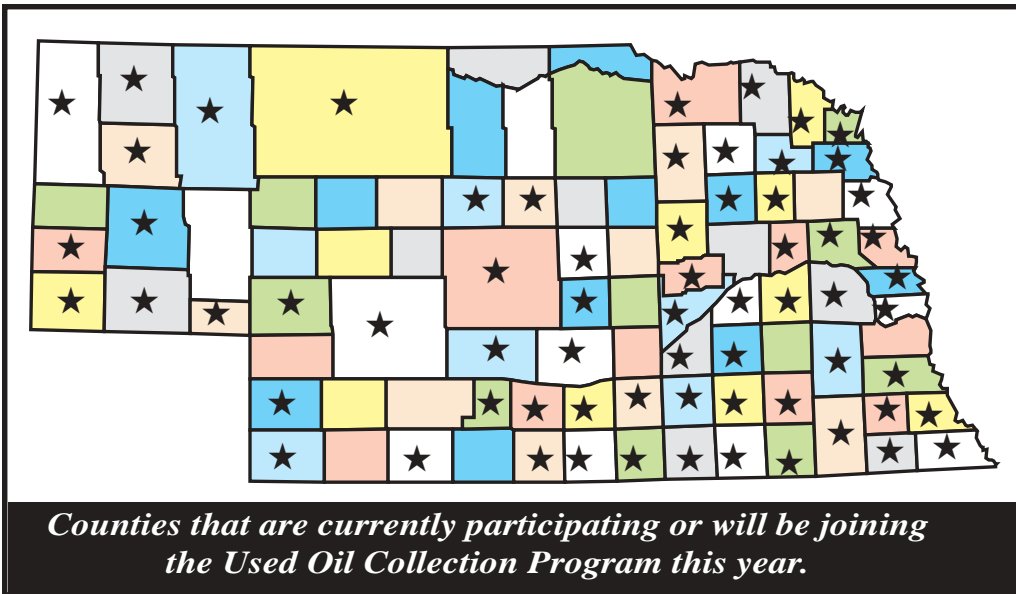
Currently, 66 out of 93 Nebraska counties have at least one collection site for used oil or are being serviced by a neighboring county. Over 90% of Nebraska citizens now have access



to an oil collection site in their county. Since the inception of the program, nearly 300,000 gallons of used oil have been collected for recycling.

## Shelving Donation Benefits Lincoln Nonprofit Organizations

Warehouse shelving that could no longer be utilized by Lincoln Benefit Life became a welcome donation for several Lincoln nonprofit organizations. 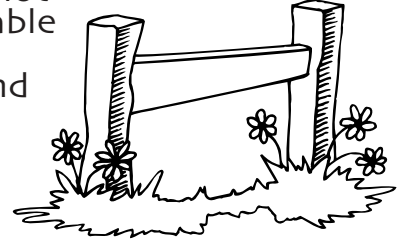

## More Success Stories!

*Proving again that one man's trash is another man's treasure....*The Exchange received a call from a woman who wanted to list two trash cans full of used lava rock. She did not want to discard usable material and asked the Exchange to find an interested party who might be able to reuse the landscaping rock. Several contacts were made, and within a week the material was picked up for use by a local church.



**An average of 136 tons of paper and cardboard are picked up and recycled each month through matches facilitated by the Materials Exchange Program.**

When a large company in Omaha began moving to a new office location, they called the Exchange in an effort to redistribute some office supplies they no longer needed. Hundreds of binders, paper clips, pencils, reams of colored paper, and labels were picked up by nonprofit organizations, churches, and after-school programs.



**Since the beginning of 2004, over 34 tons of computer and electronic scrap has been recycled by Materials Exchange participants. Recycling this scrap rather than sending it to the landfill ensures that harmful materials like lead and cadmium will not leak from the computer components and pollute our streams, top soil, and groundwater.**

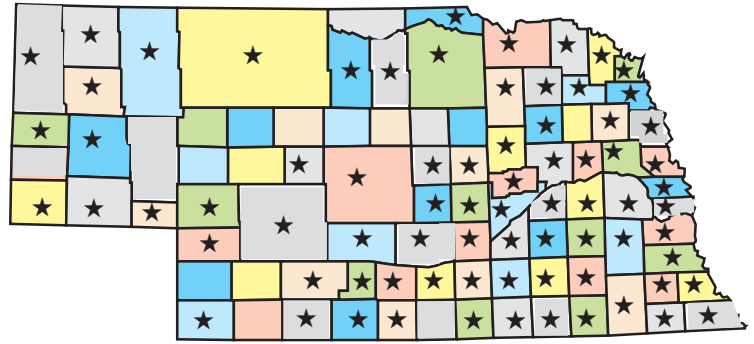

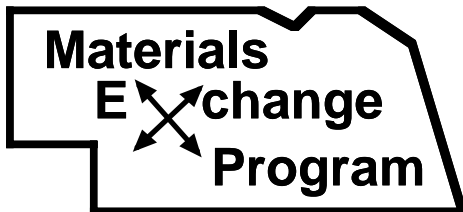

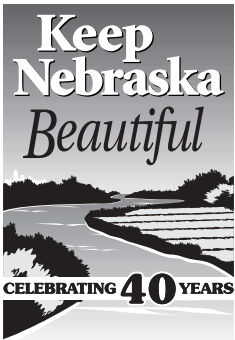
