WHITECLAY MISSION GOES THE EXTRA MILE FOR AREA RESIDENTS

Earlier this fall, Nebraska Wesleyan University in Lincoln contacted the Exchange about a number of items the University no longer needed. Some of the items included dorm bunk beds, desks, and 120 stackable chairs that had been used in the cafeteria and music department. After Exchange facilitators notified nonprofit agencies about the availability of the material, most of the items were donated to organizations in Lincoln and Omaha.

The cafeteria chairs, however, were picked up and transported across the state to the small, northwestern Nebraska town of Whiteclay. The ABOUT Group, a nonprofit outreach ministry, was working to establish a soup kitchen in Whiteclay to serve area residents, especially the Native American population on the nearby Pine Ridge Indian Reservation. After learning of the availability of the chairs, The ABOUT Group's dedicated volunteers and staff made the over 400-mile trip to Lincoln to pick up the chairs and take them back to Whiteclay.

The Whiteclay soup kitchen/dining hall where the chairs will be utilized will not be fully operational until early 2005. However, volunteers were able to serve a Thanksgiving meal to over 120 people this year!

Thanks to Nebraska Wesleyan for choosing to pursue a reuse option for their unwanted items. Thanks also to The ABOUT Group who, quite literally, went the extra mile to make sure they had the materials necessary to open the Whiteclay facility.

DONATION/REUSE CENTERS

Most of us have cleaned out our closets and garages and taken boxes of unwanted items to donation centers at local churches and homeless shelters. The used toys, clothing, appliances, and furniture that are no longer needed can be reused by individuals, nonprofit organizations, and families with limited funds to purchase new items.

But our charitable donations to thrift stores and reuse centers are equally important as an economical, environmentally-sound method to manage unwanted and surplus materials. Donating usable items not only saves landfill space, it also reduces the amount of natural resources being used to produce or reprocess products.

According to the Environmental Protection Agency, there are over 6,000 reuse centers around the country. Some well-known centers include Goodwill and the Salvation Army. Other local centers might specialize in office furniture, construction materials, and fixtures salvaged from old buildings.

So the next time you donate clothing to a thrift store or shop at a reuse center, remember....You're helping the environment at the same time!

A Norfolk company generating large quantities of wood waste asked the Exchange for help in locating a recycling option for the material. After some months, the Exchange was able to put the company in contact with a nearby lumber yard that was looking for wood waste to recycle and sell as mulch.

To date, over 70 tons of the waste has been picked up, recycled, and resold as mulch, saving the material from Nebraska landfills.

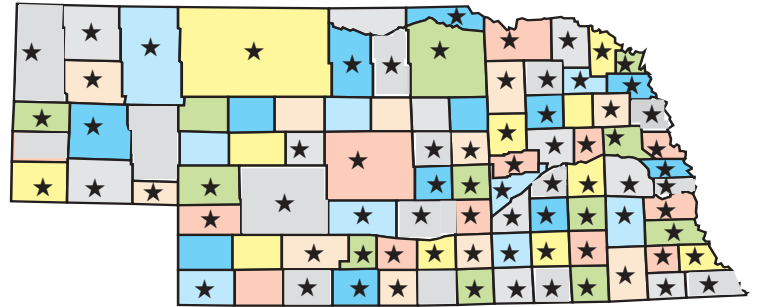

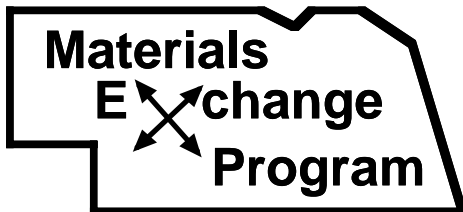
