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Nebraska Used Oil Collection and Reuse Pilot Program Begins

Keep Nebraska Beautiful, in conjunction with several other Nebraska organizations, has helped kick off the Used Oil Collection and Reuse Program. The program was developed for two primary purposes: protection of Nebraska's ground and surface water and soil, and reuse/recycling of one of our nation's under-utilized resources. The mission of the program is to provide a continual and sustainable used oil collection and reuse system statewide. As the program matures into a statewide quality management system, other materials difficult to properly dispose of conveniently and cost-effectively will be expanded into the system.

Initially, the Nebraska Used Oil Collection and Reuse Program will operate with a local used oil collection site being established in each of 8 counties where used oil can be taken to be tested for acceptance into the program. Each county will also have a mobile collection capability which can be used to service other communities within the county. The local governments currently involved in the pilot program are Richardson County, Nemaha County, Otoe County, Pawnee County, Johnson County, Saline County, Gage County and the City of Beatrice, and the City of Hastings.

When the used oil has been tested and no contamination found, it will be transferred to a used oil vendor under contract to the Nebraska Department of Roads. It will then be reused or

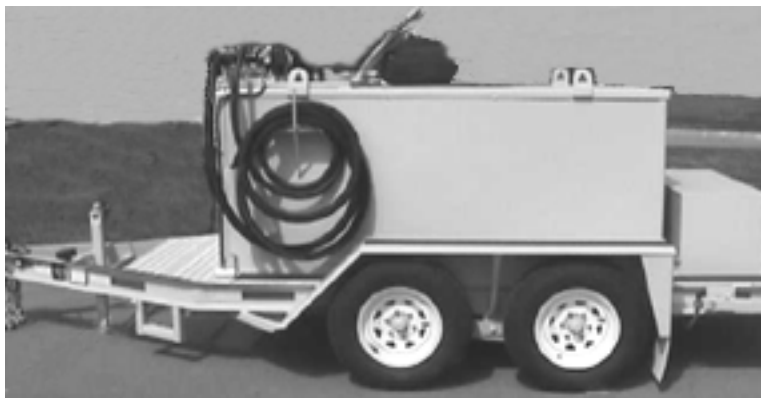
recycled in accordance with used oil management standards established by the US EPA.

This program is the outcome of a partnership between Keep Nebraska Beautiful, the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality, the Nebraska Department of Roads, and the Nebraska Association of County Officials. Numerous other organizations have assisted in the planning and implementation of the program, including:

A match made recently saved 100 gallons of paint from going to waste. Keep Schuyler Beautiful obtained the paint through the Materials Exchange Program from the Douglas County Health Department/MAPA. The paint will be used on various projects, such as painting several buildings in Schuyler and painting over graffiti.

Pet Supplies Not Abandoned

Over 5,000 bottles of dog shampoo and pet odor control found useful homes rather than going to the landfill. The products came from a Nebraska manufacturer, who had discontinued its production. Materials Exchange facilitator, Allen Grell, was able to find two very willing recipients for the products—two different Humane Societies in Nebraska. More Computers Find New Homes

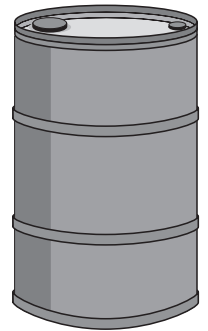

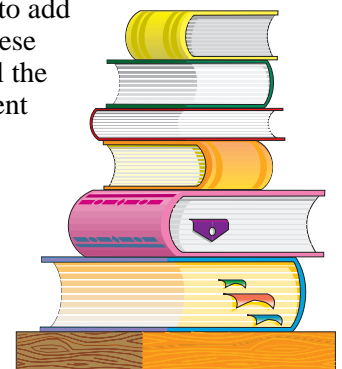


Shrink Wrap

Most industries use large quantities of it, but maybe not enough to justify buying a bailer. Yet shrink wrap is a valuable recyclable that numerous recyclers are willing to pay for...but only if it is bailed. If your business generates large quantities of shrink wrap please let us know. If we have a known large quantity of shrink wrap in several area businesses we may be able to persuade a recycler to work with us on this issue and develop a solution beneficial to all involved.

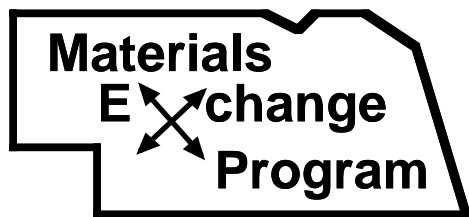

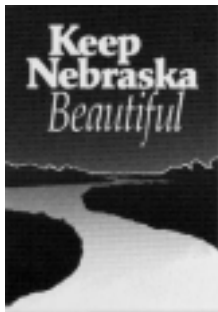
