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Slim Budget Forges Working Friendship

Last summer, with a nearly nonexistent budget, Shanan Christian School near Gibbon, Nebraska needed to update their three older computers. Fourteen year old Jake Winchester was helping his mother with this task by going to endless garage sales where he found expensive, very outdated equipment. He convinced his mom to take him to Junkman's Recycling in Kearney which advertised computers for sale in the local newspaper.

They bought one computer for \$125, skeptical as to how well it would work and for how long. After it was set up it worked great. So, they went back for another one. As they purchased more computers, Larry Andersen, owner of the recycling center, started asking questions such as What were the computers for? What other parts did they need? Did they need monitors, printers? Each time he asked a question, he donated extra equipment. The slim budget stretched and stretched.

Larry and Jake soon began to share with each other what they knew about computers and a working relationship developed. When Andersen's computer technician went back to school, Jake asked if he could try the job. Andersen sent a few computers and parts home with Jake over a long weekend and by Monday he brought them back, ready to go.

Junkman's Recycling recycles computers

from all over Nebraska. Early this fall, they received shipments from several schools. The systems were quite old, but some contained early learning games. Andersen thought there had to be someone who could use them and he asked Jake what he thought.

Jake contacted the Salvation Army and Head Start and learned that they would both be interested. He lined up help from his older brother and other members of

the newly formed Shanan Christian School FFA. They spent hours sorting through piles of computers and hauled many loads to the school. Jake tested the systems and removed unneeded files. The others tested cords and cables and cleaned the units. After more than 400 hours were invested in the project the

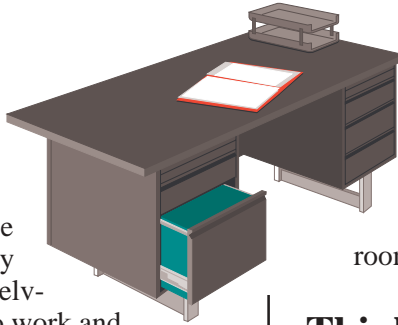

Within two days, not only were these computers matched, but they were also set up at their final destination and ready for use. Warm Reception For Freezer

Here is another example of the Exchange program at its best. BryanLGH Medical Center contacted us to list a large commercial freezer. It was still relatively new and in great shape but no longer filled their needs. Although there was no one actively seeking a freezer in our listings, with a little investigative work we located two interested parties. It basically came down to who got there first, and the lucky winner was the science department of a nearby small college. In this win/win situation BryanLGH saved on disposal costs and the college received a \$5,000 piece of equipment for free.

Adhesive Film Now Available

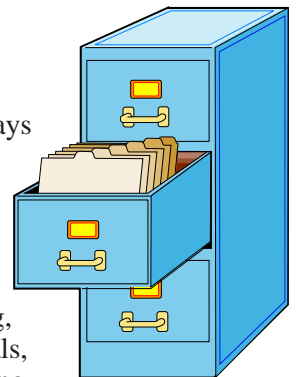

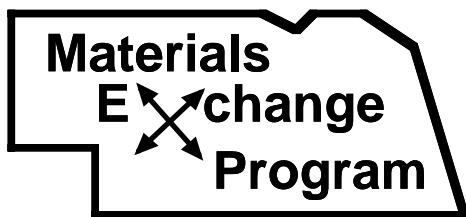
