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Materials Exchange Program Welcomes Wesflex

The Nebraska Materials Exchange Program is proud to introduce Wesflex Pipe Manufacturing of Beatrice, Nebraska to *The Link* subscribers and exchange participants. Wesflex is one of Nebraska's most recent economic development achievements due to the combined efforts of the Nebraska Department of Economic Development, Nebraska Public Power District, Gage County, Gage County Economic Development Corporation, and the City of Beatrice. These efforts enabled Nebraska to snatch this West Coast plant expansion from the grasp of many surrounding states seeking to land this high-quality company.

Wesflex's corporate offices are located in Shasta Lake, California near Sacramento. Wesflex Pipe Manufacturing produces many types of plastic pipe. Company officials realized the need to expand their operations to the Midwest due to high volumes of sales occurring in Colorado, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas, and Wyoming. To address this need Wesflex began operation in Beatrice on May 1, 2000, where they manufacture plastic pipe for use in the installation of fiber optic cable.

Wesflex is truly an environmentally conscientious company. They use only 10% virgin material in the production of their pipe. The remaining 90% of their raw material is reused #2 High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) plastic. At the Beatrice plant, Wesflex reuses between 6,000 and 10,000 pounds of #2 HDPE daily! Wesflex also participates in similar exchange programs in Arkansas, Colorado, Maryland, Texas, and Washington.

Wesflex is seeking Nebraska generators of #2 HDPE to help achieve their

production goals of 10-15 reels a day, seven days a week. The Materials Exchange Program is anxious to help match these generators with Wesflex so they can fill their empty reels to meet the demands of a growing industry. If you or an organization you know generates #2

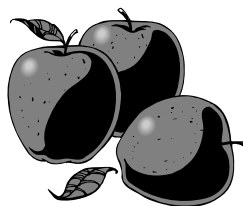
A CLOSER EXAMINATION: Success Stories

Another Nebraska company is able to take the material, which is then shipped to another location to be made into carpet pads. This match has been going on for several months and will continue indefinitely, producing a useful product from a material that might have gone to the landfill.

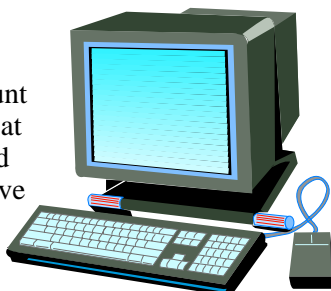


Drafting Class Benefits From Match

Fortunately, the Exchange was able to hook up these two parties and a perfect match was made.

Computers Are Moving

This summer the Materials Exchange Program has been involved in matching an incredible amount of computers. The latest numbers aren't available at press time, but the amounts are significant. Instead of going to the landfill, the working computers have gone to schools, daycares, several non-profit organizations, individuals, and companies. Non-working computers have gone to recyclers so that the metals, plastics, and other materials can be used again. Congratulations to all Nebraska exchangers who helped make this happen!



Just What You Need

Everyone uses them, yet many have trouble getting rid of useable ones that are no longer need. What are they? PALLETS! One of the items we have the most listings for are pallets. The materials exchange database shows over 60 companies generating excess pallets. We are able to match up many of these with companies seeking pallets, but there are still many that go unused. These excess pallets often stack up and become a storage problem, then eventually end up in the landfill. The bottom line is they are a problem for these companies and the companies involved would be thrilled if you could take some or all

of their excess pallets off their hands.

The available pallets come in a seemingly endless variety of sizes and styles, mostly wood, some plastic. And quantities these companies are generating range from a few each month to over 500 each week. So if you need pallets, chances are good that you can find the quantity and size that you need through our exchange. Give us a call or send an e-mail and we will do our best to find the pallets you need.

No Wood, Mate!

If you are shipping product to Australia be aware that they will not allow any pallets or crates made from wood. Australian authorities have put this ban in place due to concerns of importing exotic pests. The Materials Exchange Program was able to make a match recently for a company needing plastic pallets to comply with the ban when shipping their product down under.

Ongoing Match

A year ago we reported a match in which the Exchange located an end user for the lime by-product from the Village of Dakota City water treatment plant. The recipient of this material uses the lime as a soil amendment. We are happy to report that this match continues and the amount to be exchanged during this year will total 750 tons!

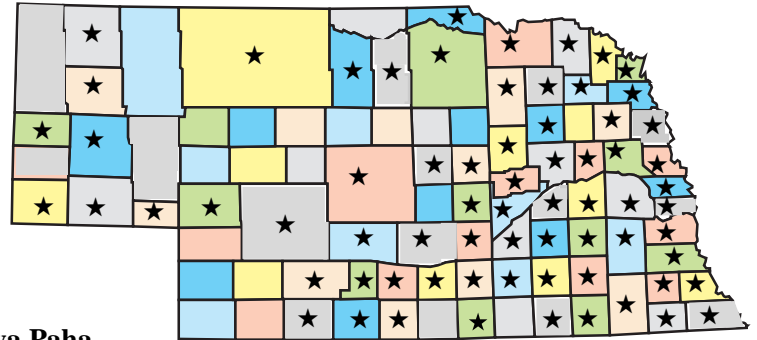

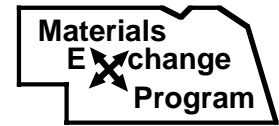

Avoid Computer Disposal Problems

Is your electronic equipment becoming obsolete? What will you do with your old computer when you get a new one?

Due to increasing numbers of electronic equipment sent to landfills, Massachusetts environmental officials have instituted the nation's first ban on disposal of computer screens, television sets, and other glass picture tubes in landfills and incinerators.

Cathode ray tubes (CRTs) in screens contain 5 to 8 pounds of lead that can seep into the groundwater under landfills or, if the tube is incinerated, get into the air.

Donating old, but **working** computer equipment to nonprofit

organizations or individuals through the Nebraska Materials Exchange Program can help you avoid computer equipment disposal problems. A large network of participants are seeking current or outdated **working** equipment for reuse.

As more businesses and individuals update their equipment, the Materials Exchange Program looks forward to making many more matches with nonprofit, day care, and school participants.

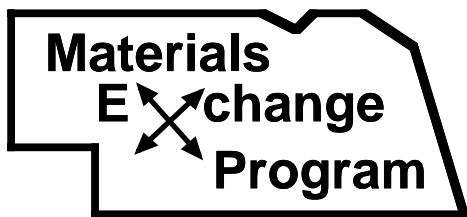
