Materials Exchange Program Participants Help Win National Keep America Beautiful Award

Thanks to Nebraska Materials Exchange Program participants, the Keep Nebraska Beautiful Exchange Program received the 1999 First Place Award for Outstanding Waste-Minimization Programs at Keep America Beautiful's 46th Annual Award Conference in Washington, D.C., Dec. 11, 1999.

The Materials Exchange Program, which was started in 1994, was recognized for its excellence in helping Nebraska businesses reduce waste through reuse and recycling.

The program has facilitated 570 exchanges of materials between businesses, industries, non-profits and individuals.

These matches diverted more than 4 million pounds of materials from Nebraska landfills and represents a cost savings of more than \$900,000.

Founded in 1964, Keep Nebraska Beautiful, Inc. is a not-for-profit environmental education organization and a statewide affiliate of Keep America Beautiful.

Glass Crusher Improves Recycled Glass Market

A new glass beneficiation system at Midland Recycling in Lincoln provides a means to process glass for recycling in Nebraska.

Glass was not a valuable commodity for recycling for most of Nebraska prior to installation of the new system. The excessive shipping costs of glass to end markets in other states can be prohibitive. The new system at Midland Recycling opens up markets in the state for glass by crushing the glass.

Midland Recycling has increased the amount of glass they recycle from 20 tons in October 1999 to 225 tons in January 2000.

In addition to the exchange program, Keep Nebraska Beautiful sponsors the Great American Cleanup™, a buy-recycled education program, teacher workshops and "Grow Big Red," a program which encourages Nebraskans to plant red flowers. Currently, a statewide used oil collection and reuse program is being developed.

Recycled glass can be found in sand products, aggregate material, concrete, drainage and filtration systems and glass containers.

Recycled glass is used in: sandblasting, sand traps at golf courses, oil spill cleanup, ice control (as a replacement for salt), beach sand, landscaping projects, asphalt paving, stepping stones, retaining wall blocks, lawn ornaments, pottery, drain pipe bedding and backfill, septic tank drain fields and retaining wall back fill.

Recycled glass end products include fiber-glass, marbles, glass beads, jewelry, roof tile and industrial flooring.

Background: Five and one-half tons of plate glass were delivered to Washington County Recycling Center by the Nebraska Department of Roads. The glass was crushed in the recycling center's new glass aggregate machine. The crushed glass will be mixed with snow melting materials and applied to Washington County roads during snow and ice storms.

Elwood fourth grade teacher Jo D. Blessing is singing the praises of the Materials Exchange Program.

"The K N B Materials Exchange Program was extremely successful in providing the Elwood fourth grade with a fantastic birding swap," Blessing said.

Blessing said she and her students received a lot more than the bird books she requested.

Through the exchange program, Blessing met Dr. Paul Johnsgard, an ornithologist from the University of Nebraska who has written nearly 40 books on birds. He supplied Blessing's class with some of the books he had written.

"The K N B Materials Exchange Program is responsible for one of the nicest friendships I have ever been privileged to share. Dr. Johnsgard has been invaluable to my classroom and our Classroom Feeder Watch," stated Blessing.

Johnsgard traveled to Blessing's classroom to talk about owls, brought specimens for them to view and helped them study owl pellets.

Johnsgard also responds to the students' bird questions via e-mail.
